For **Embroidery**, **Screen Printing** and **Vinyl Heat Press**, please send us only Vector graphics. Acceptable formats: .eps .ai .svg

DO NOT SEND: .PNG, .JPG, .TIFF, .PSD, .BMP, or GIF

For Direct to Garment Printing,
Acceptable formats: .eps .ai .svg .PSD .TIFF JPG, PNG, BMP, or GIF

Vector art is created using vector illustration software programs, such as Adobe Illustrator or Corel Draw



MY ART ISN'T VECTOR! WHAT NOW?

If you had a professional designer create your art, chances are they created your design as vector art, but could have neglected to provide you with the vector files. Contact your designer, and ask for the vector files. If you work in a large company, contact your company's marketing department or design department. They will probably have the files that you need.

If you discover that you have a non-vector art file, and you need vector art, there's only one thing to do: Hire a graphic designer to re-create your design as vector art. We can re-create your design as vector art for \$60/HR
